Old Business:

Kayak and Boat launch: Randy, Jacob, Dan and Chuck met and went over fundraising avenue. Randy is trying to amend the DNR grant to help maybe add \$33,000. Local companies have been discussed and they divided up who will approach them. \$50,000 more was asked for. A revised quote came through that was a bit of a surprise. Goal to get in within the next 2 weeks. Asked to have Distinguished Design at the presentation again. Why did the cost go up is the big question?

West Side Park Subdivision: Randy reported: Warner Homes is reviewing development agreement. No big point has been objected to. Hoping to have comments back by the end of the month to get the agreement locked up.
